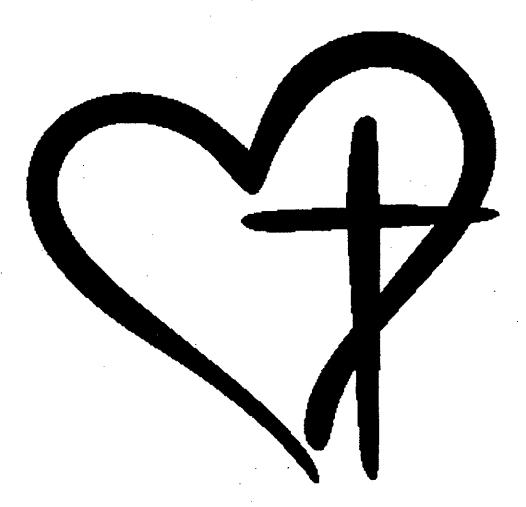

Pastor's Report

The year 2018 brought some unexpected changes along with some new hopes and dreams. We saw growth spiritually and numerically. It was an exciting year in the life of the church.

We cannot think back on 2018 without remembering the major change that took place at Flora FCC. On July 1, 2018, we decided as a congregation to withdraw from the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) (DOC). This was an extremely difficult decision. The feeling for most was one of remorse due to the fact that we reached a point where we felt we needed to even think about our affiliation with the denomination. After much prayer, discussion, and more prayer, we made the decision to break ties with DOC based on our understanding that Christ is the One and Only Savior and our understanding of the authority of scripture.

We worked hard this year on growing our relationships with the other churches in Carroll County. We began partnering with Flora Presbyterian's Oasis program. On Halloween night, we took part in the Community Trunk or Treat with other area churches reaching a large portion of the families in Flora.

Our church family seemed to be hit hard with illness and the passing of several loved ones. Cancer became a "four-letter word" for us all as we witnessed several of our members being affected by it. Fortunately, we were able to celebrate many miracles and never doubted in the darkest of days that God was working in ways we did not understand.

Our spirits were awakened at the ideas of growing our preschool and youth ministry. As new members joined, we felt a pulse of new life flowing through our veins. Each Sunday brought new faces and LOTS of fellowshipping and laughter. At the same time, our "virtual" presence increased using Facebook, Instagram, and YouTube increasing our reach in ways we did not anticipate.

One of the most precious moments I was able to experience in 2018 occurred in April. Eight of us returned to Decatur, Illinois for the Disciple Heritage Fellowship National Gathering. While there, we were able to celebrate one year from our first meeting at the gathering in 2017. It served as a reminder that we may not always see what God is doing, but if we trust in Him, all things will work for His good and our benefit.

We sang his praises loudly as we worshipped and learned much alongside our brothers and sisters in Christ.

In December at the annual congregation meeting, we selected our new church leaders for 2019. During that same meeting, we voted as a congregation to affiliate with Disciple Heritage Fellowship (DHF). We were blessed to have two of their leaders fill our pulpit during the year. Firsthand, we were able to experience the desire of DHF to work alongside individual churches.

We were invited to take part in the Genda Funeral Home Back to School block party. We had a spin the wheel Bible trivia game thanks to Rhonda Hicks. Pastor Kim purchased some prizes. Thank you to the church members who volunteered to assist with the block party.

Trunk or Treat was held on October 31st for anyone who wanted to participate providing a safe place for children to visit. A few FFCC families participated along with numerous other churches. It was held in the Mann's Parking lot across the street from the church.

The Beef and Noodle Fundraiser was November 11th. Thanks to Margie Spray for cooking up her famous beef and noodle dish! The funds were used for the annual children's Christmas Shopping for the Christmas Box Project.

The Annual Christmas Family Night was December2nd. The Evening consisted of decorating the annex Christmas tree. Kids decorated ornaments to add to the tree. Favorite Christmas snacks were shared from everyone who attended, and we played Connect Four with Bible Trivia questions to place a game piece.

The Christmas Shopping trip was December 16th and young people of all ages participated.

A new Elementary Youth Group was started in the Fall, led by Dawn Clawson, with the help of other members of the Education Committee.

As we move forward into 2019, we will be looking at several new activities. We will be starting a high school Sunday School and youth group and planning more youth related activities for all ages while continuing to work with our current youth and growing the numbers.

First Step Preschool Report (2018-2019 School Year)

Staff: Jane Edging, director/head teacher Mindy Evans, Pre-K assistant (M, W, F)
Andrea Bray, Nursery assistant (T, Th) Ashley Duff, readiness assistant (M, W, Th)

Pre-K Class started up on Wednesday, August 22, 2018 with 21 students. Registration fee collected upon enrollment was \$65 per student. Tuition of \$95 per month began in September and runs through May.

Nursery Class began on Thursday, August 23, 2018 with 14 students. Registration fee collected upon enrollment was \$65 per student. Tuition of \$75 per month began in September and runs through May.

Field trips: Pre-K, October, to the Tippecanoe Co. Fire Prevention Show via Carroll School Corp school bus. Nursery, October, walked to the Flora Fire Station for a tour of the facility & to learn fire safety.

Fundraiser: This year marked the 14th annual Chicken Bash/Gift Basket Contest fundraiser. A total of 486 adult and 93 child meal tickets sold = \$5415. Gift basket contest tickets sales total \$1197. After expenses, total net return was \$3214.61 resulting in the most successful fundraiser!

Thanksgiving Feasts: Parents of both classes chip in to provide a complete Thanksgiving meal to sit down and eat with their child! The feasts are held on either the Monday or Tuesday of Thanksgiving week. The preschool provides the turkeys for each meal.

Attendance: Pre-K Class lost one student due to family moving and two students due to parent's jobs/ability getting child to/from school. Nursery class lost one child at end of December but gained two children in January. Currently Pre-K has 18 students and Nursery has 15 students.

Weather: Parents do not have to pay tuition for the days their child attends in August which makes up for delays/cancellations. However, due to the high number of delays and days cancelled due to the weather this past winter, both classes are dismissing at 12:30 pm vs Noon thru the remainder of the current school year.

Upcoming Events: Open registration enrollment April 10 and 11 from 2:00 pm - 5:30 pm. The Nursery class for the upcoming school year is already more than half full due to advance registrations!

Pre-K Class will take a Carroll school bus to Columbian Park Zoo on April 24. Both classes will go on walking field trips in April, and both classes will have an end-of-year.

Field trip/picnic in May (dates to be determined). Last day of school and graduation program on Thursday, May 23 @ 7:00 pm
